Re: FL A30171 – Cutting Permit 404 – Stakeholder Referral

Cooper Creek Cedar is completing the development of Cutting Permit 404 – Laird Creek/Balfour Face. The intent of this letter is to share information to interested Stakeholders regarding the final proposed development of CP 404 and to initiate discussions about specific interests that may be impacted by CCC's proposed development in the Laird Creek/Balfour Face Forest Development Unit. The planned development includes the following proposed cutblocks and roads:

- four cutblocks – approximately 65-ha (net area) / approximately 25,000-m³. CCC has made changes to blocks 3 & 4 from the original planned development; therefore, blocks 3 & 4 are included in this referral.
- approximately 1.3-km new road construction (note: a Road Permit was previously issued to CCC for the Laird Creek extension and spurs. Construction of the extension and spurs is completed, except for approximately 300-m at the end of the extension).

The following information is included with this referral letter for each development area:

- Key map showing the location of the planned development
- Cutting permit map showing a detailed overview of the planned development
- KML files showing the cutblocks and the road locations
- Shape files
- Lidar Hillshade maps

The *Detailed Terrain Stability Field Assessment* for CP 404 – Blocks 3 & 4 and *Cut Block Terrain Site Reviews* for CP 404 Blocks 6 & 15 has been completed. The *Biodiversity Assessments (Ungulate Winter Range, Connectivity, Old + Mature Timber)* have been completed. The assessments can be viewed at Cooper Creek Cedar Ltd's website:
